5 Day Itinerary

Family holidays don't get any better than this! Adventures, Australian wildlife, fantastic beaches and aquatic activities, farm life, mazes and magic in four exciting regions. You can pick your own fruit, sweeten up at a chocolate factory, have lunch at fun cafés. Lots of holiday parks and spacious family apartments for your overnight stays too.



FOR KIDS OF ALL AGES

Rediscover your inner child when you take your family on this fantastic five-day self-drive tour.

You can choose your route – drive from Melbourne to Geelong and the Bellarine Peninsula, across Port Phillip Bay by ferry to the Mornington Peninsula, then drive to Phillip Island and the Yarra Valley. Or you can head for the Yarra Valley, and do the whole circuit in reverse.

This touring route is so compact with so many attractions – it's perfect for families because the kids will never have time to say 'Are we there yet?' You'll find places to visit and explore within about 30 minutes of each other all

along the route. And best of all, you don't need to come back to the city each night because there's a huge choice of accommodation along the way.

You can arrange your itinerary to take in all your kids' interests and even sneak in a little education as you travel... Australian history, wildlife in sanctuaries and natural habitats, national parks, water sports including snorkelling with seals, diving with dolphins or sea kayaking. And land adventures from tree surfing to an aerial gondola, an historic steam train to bike hire in a national park.

Every night there's a different accommodation option... self-contained cottages, family villas, beach-side holiday parks, glamping and more.

CHOOSE YOUR OWN THEMES

You can easily make Australian history and wildlife front and centre of your travels. There's a 100-year-old vintage steam train and a working farm of the same era, wildlife sanctuaries where you see a platypus and hand-feed wallabies, a koala reserve and Phillip Island's famous penguin parade each night.

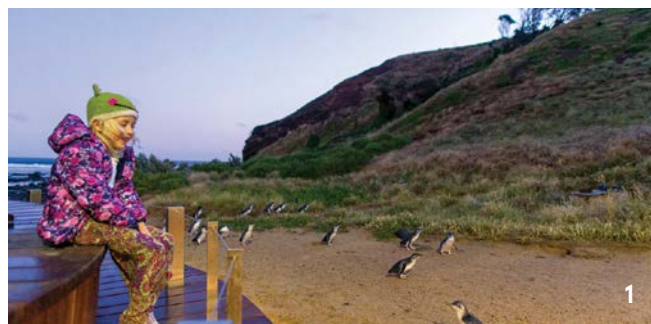
Just outside Geelong, an Aboriginal cultural centre has lots of hands-on activities including boomerang throwing, bush tucker tasting and hand-feeding animals. Indeed, Geelong was once the centre of a huge wool boom, and a museum in a restored 1872 bluestone wool store tells many intriguing stories.

DIAL UP THE ADVENTURE

When there's energy to burn, the Mornington Peninsula's tree adventures with bridges, nets, tight ropes and tunnels are set to go. Out in the ocean from the Mornington Peninsula and the Bellarine, sea creatures intrigue and entertain. Diving or kayaking with dolphins, snorkelling with curious weedy sea dragons, swimming with seals, or just enjoying the sea spray and fresh air from a comfortable boat while the kids get right in amongst it.

Fun is the name of the family game too, and there's plenty of it. Tractor rides on a tulip farm in the Yarra Valley, whip cracking on an historic farm, enjoy interactive experiences on an immersive Antarctic journey, getting lost in mazes on Phillip Island and the Mornington Peninsula.

Feeling hungry? Make your own chocolate masterpiece on Phillip Island, take a fruit tasting tractor tour through an orchard, pick your own cherries in summer. And there's a huge range of cafés, wineries, ale houses and restaurants, including family-friendly bistros, BBQs and stone-cooked pizzas.

DESIGN YOUR JOURNEY WITH TRIP PLANNER

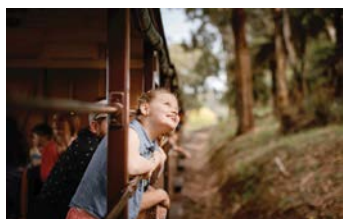
It is so easy to design your own journey linking the four extraordinary regions Beyond Melbourne.

1. Decide the order in which you wish to link each region.
2. Select EACH attraction and accommodation you wish to experience in your first regional destination, adding them to Trip Planner as you go. Then move on to add options from your second regional destination and so on.
3. Note you can add up to 23 options (MAX) in total.
4. Once you have selected all the places you want to visit Beyond Melbourne, click on the TRIP PLANNER button at the top of your screen.
5. Once you are happy with the order of your choices, click on DOWNLOAD TRIP PLAN to see your entire journey both pictorially and mapped out with times and distances between attractions.

Puffing Billy Steam Railway – Share the sense of wonder of steam train travel with the whole family aboard! Puffing Billy is a thrilling experience. Board the 100-year old heritage steam train and journey through winding forests and fern gullies, across historic timber bridges to Gembrook, the perfect family picnic spot.

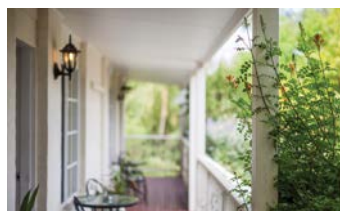

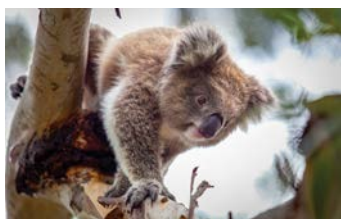

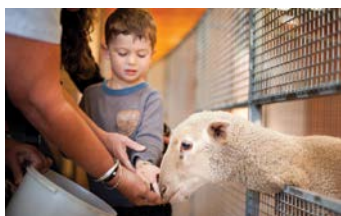

MORNING ACTIVITIES



Phillip Island Nature Parks Koala Reserve – See koalas in their natural environment, explore the tree top boardwalks. Wander extensive trails through the natural Australian bushland and enjoy the abundant birdlife. The woodland is home to many animals including wallabies, echidnas and bats. penguins.org.au



Phillip Island Nature Parks – Churchill Island – A tiny gem off Phillip Island. A 19th century working farm, it's magnificently preserved with heritage equipment, farm animals, beautiful gardens and historic buildings. Get involved in the daily farm activities of blacksmithing, milking, sheep shearing, whip cracking and working dog demonstration. penguins.org.au

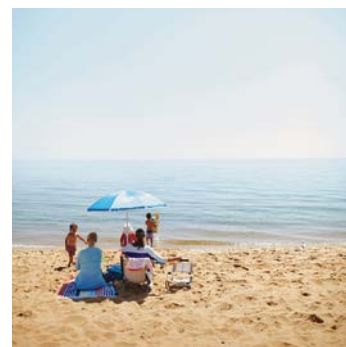

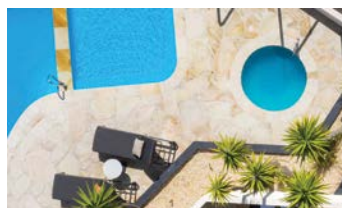
