Victoria has some of the world's most intriguing animals...bounding kangaroos and wallabies, koalas perched in trees, spiky echidnas, curious platypus in rivers and little penguins popping out of the sea at dusk every day. So come and have fantastic adventures on land, sea and in the air, discovering wildlife and dramatic natural wilderness areas.

AS WILD AS YOU WANT

Wildlife and adventure in Victoria can be as wild as you want – or a relaxed, laidback experience. The climate is kind, the scenery spectacular, the oceans are clean and the air so fresh. And there are so many options for getting close up to wildlife and choosing adventures.

You can visit wildlife in famous sanctuaries, take a small-group wilderness tour or explore on your own. Maritime experts welcome you on a cruise to one of Australia's largest fur seal colonies, or you can slip off a specially equipped boat to swim with wild dolphins and seals.

Wind through forests and fern gullies on a 100-year-old steam train, or go surfing over the tree tops. Take a fun hot air ballooning ride over vines and farmlands.

And you're never far from a winery, café or restaurant in the countryside or along the coast. Accommodation is just as varied, from glamping to luxury cottages with resident kangaroos and farmstays.

It's all so easy when you Go Beyond Melbourne. Just choose your route – from Melbourne to Geelong, the Mornington Peninsula, Phillip Island, then the Yarra Valley. Or head for the Yarra Valley, and do the circuit in reverse.

A REALLY WILD WELCOME

If you're a wildlife lover, you simply won't believe your luck. You're absolutely guaranteed of meeting wildlife – and feeding, patting, swimming, diving and walking with it.

There are wildlife sanctuaries, reserves and tours in every region. Top experiences include the platypus discovery experience, diving with dolphins, seals and weedy sea dragons. You can walk along treetop boardwalks in a koala sanctuary, watch the little penguins at dusk on Phillip Island, take a lantern-lit night-time tour where little gliders will take nectar from your hand.

Bird lovers flock to a sanctuary that's home to 150 species of birds, a spirits of the sky bird presentation, and the chance to get right up close to rare and endangered species.

HELLO ADRENALIN!

Soar through the treetops on flying foxes, take a high ropes climbing challenge, ride the zipline high above magnificent gardens. Go even higher on a dawn balloon flight, floating over vineyards before a champagne breakfast.

French Island is a little treasure trove of natural wilderness, just a ferry ride from the Mornington Peninsula or Phillip Island. Hop into an off-road vehicle and go discovering.

Jet boats and racing boats give you a thrill a minute as you explore Phillip Island's dramatic coastlines, or cruise out to one of Australia's largest wild fur seal colonies at Seal Rocks.

In the You Yangs, north of Geelong, eco tours show you Australian wildlife in its natural habitat, or you can strike out on your own and hike to the top of Flinders Peak.

There's accommodation with an adventurous tweak too... luxury cottages surrounded by a nature reserve, glamping and hosted lakeside accommodation.

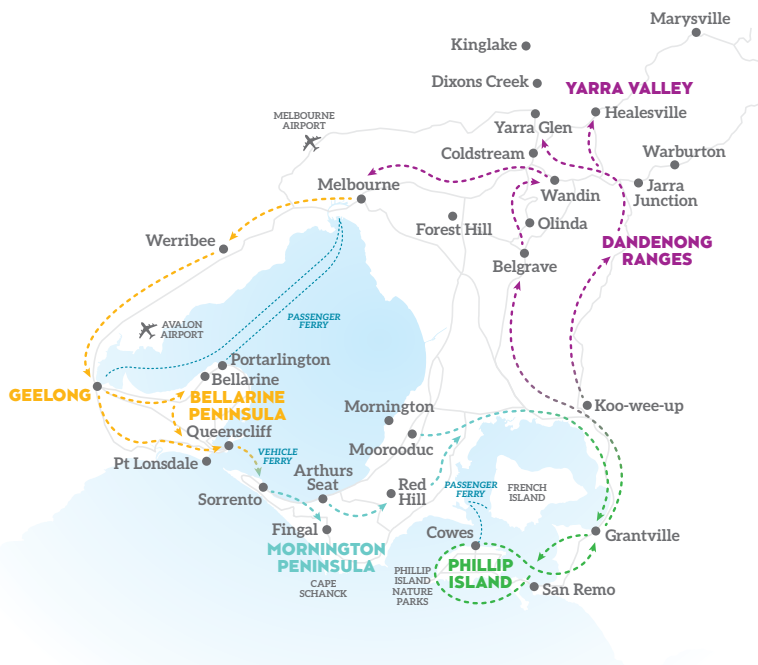

DESIGN YOUR JOURNEY WITH TRIP PLANNER

It is so easy to design your own journey linking the four extraordinary regions Beyond Melbourne.

1. Decide the order in which you wish to link each region.
2. Select EACH attraction and accommodation you wish to experience in your first regional destination, adding them to Trip Planner as you go. Then move on to add options from your second regional destination and so on.
3. Note you can add up to 23 options (MAX) in total.
4. Once you have selected all the places you want to visit Beyond Melbourne, click on the TRIP PLANNER button at the top of your screen.
5. Once you are happy with the order of your choices, click on DOWNLOAD TRIP PLAN to see your entire journey both pictorially and mapped out with times and distances between attractions.

Naturaliste Tours

Phillip Island Nature Parks Koala Reserve

– As dusk falls, witness these endearing little creatures emerge from the sea and scurry to their burrows. 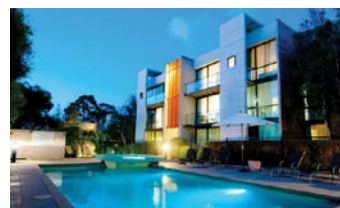

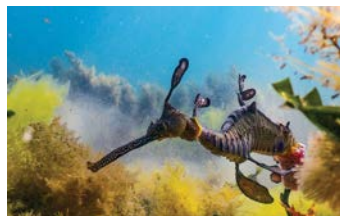
AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES

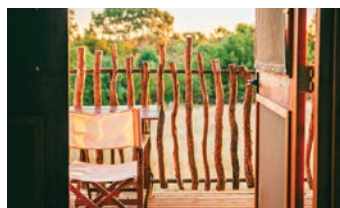
