



## YARRA VALLEY & DANDENONG RANGES

Hit the track at Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit or reach new heights with individually themed wall challenges at Clip 'N Climb. The Phillip Island Nature Parks nightly Penguin Parade is not to be missed! Stay overnight at The Island Accommodation – YHA, Ramada Resort Phillip Island, or Bimbadeen Phillip Island – a real Aussie working farm.

## MORNINGTON PENINSULA

Mornington Peninsula is a land of abundance; of farmgate trails, cellar doors and chef's hatted restaurants.

Of bubbling thermal hot springs and lantern-lit after-dark wildlife adventures. Dive with the dolphins, swim with the seals and golf like no one's watching.

Follow the wine, food and farmgate trail then settle into a vineyard estate surrounded by stunning vistas or a seaside apartment and drift off to the sound of crashing waves.

Pick-your-own at Sunny Ridge Strawberry Farm. Gaze and graze at T'Gallant Winemakers.

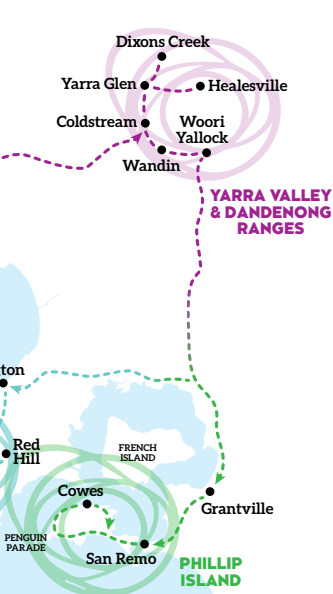

Get a bird's eye view with Phillip Island Helicopters and create a personalised masterpiece at Phillip Island Chocolate Factory.



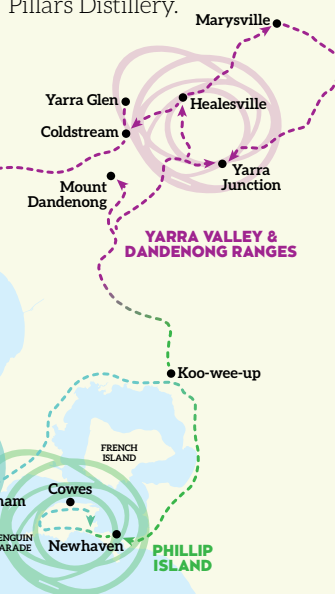

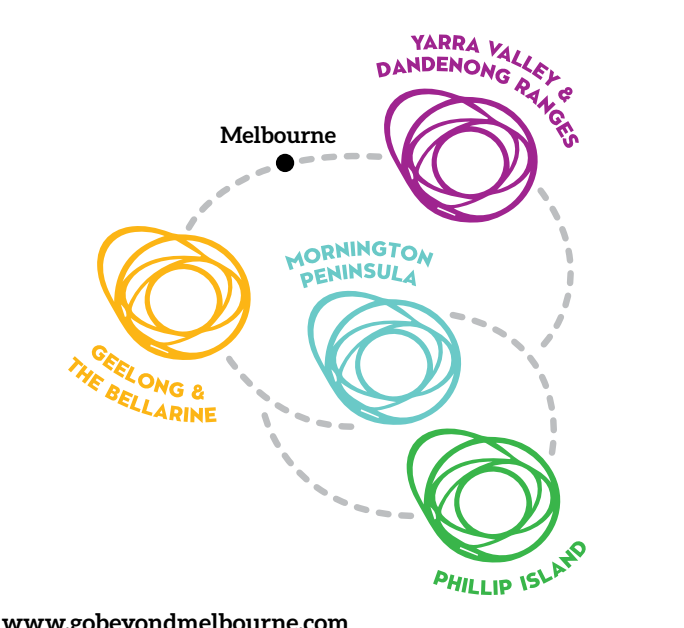

### PLANNING SEAMLESS VISITOR JOURNEYS

All four Go Beyond Melbourne regions link to each other or Melbourne via either 60-minute or 90-minute drives, or a scenic cross-bay ferry cruise. Think of Go Beyond as looping, not linear.

Planning a visitor itinerary depends on number of travel days, visitor interests and key activities. Within those parameters, there are oodles of choices. You can link two, three or all four regions and create a seamless journey for visitors – a looping route that transitions effortlessly onto the next region without any need to return to the city overnight.
